

MONDAY, JULY 10TH. 1933.

At a regularly recessed meeting of the Board of County Commissioners at which all Members of said Commission were present, John H Miller, Chairman, J B Gray and H E Bridges, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had:

Motion was made by Commissioner Bridges, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the County Attorney be and he is hereby requested to furnish an opinion as to the validity of claim No. 216798 in the amount of \$2,221.92, Force Account, on repairs on Bridge located at Thirty-First and Riverside Drive. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that Chas. W. Lovell, Skiatook, Oklahoma be given an allowance in the sum of Six (\$6.00.) Dollars per month until further notice. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. with all members present and presiding as before. John H Miller, Chairman, J B Gray and H E Bridges, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

In the matter of the application of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line under, through and across certain highways, the following order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this the 12th. day of July, 1933, the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State, came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point within the
highway at the intersection of 51st. Street
and Lewis Avenue, within the Northwest corner
of Section 32, Township 19 North, Range 13, East
and extending South along the East side of Lewis
Avenue a distance of 646 feet, for the purpose of
serving domestic consumers.

And, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so
