Said Building Lease is dated December 6th, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of R. W. Brooks as fee deputy at Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby confirmed. Said deputy shall receive fees and mileage on process served as provided by law and shall receive no fees in excess of \$100.00 in any one quarter. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Constable Bond filed by Ed Ward and approved on December 12th, 1938, be and the same is hereby ordered cancelled for the reason that a Surety Bond is necessary; the bond being cancelled is a personal bond.
