

Moved by Selph, seconded by Rice, to approve the purchase of computer hardware and software for the Treasurer's office in the total amount of \$72,529. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Rice, yes; Selph, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc. File No. 126314)

Blakeley was present to discuss counsel for the Board of County Commissioners. Under Attorney General Opinion 88-60, the BOCC can contract with the District Attorney to hire additional employees for services to the BOCC. Chairman recognizes the need, but questions the availability of funding for an additional attorney. Blakeley stated it would cost approximately \$53,000 a year. Moved by Rice, seconded by Harris, to support the concept of providing funding to hire counsel for BOCC and include in budget proposal of FY 89-90. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Rice, yes; Selph, abstain. Motion declared carried.
