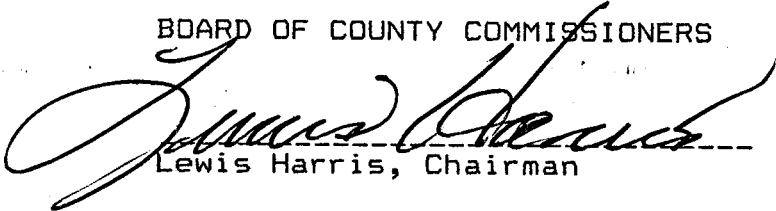
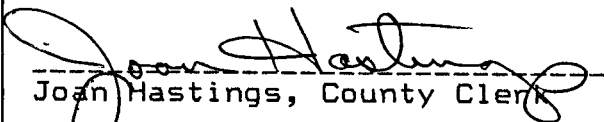

MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

Thursday, May 26, 1988

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman; John Selph, Member; Melvin C. Rice, Member. Members absent: None. Others present: Leroy Jones; Jack Gordon; Jeanette Bradley; Jim Crawley; Jack Helton; Linda Knowles; Wayne Carr; Clay Edwards; Ray Hasselman; Dr. Kara Gae Wilson; Vera Carroll.

Lewis Harris, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m., and the following business was transacted:

Leroy Jones requested Board approval to purchase a Personal System computer and related hardware and software for installation in the office of the Tulsa County Superintendent of Schools. The estimated cost for this installation is \$5,000 and Jeanette Bradley, with Superintendent's office, concurred funds are budgeted and available. Motion made by Selph, seconded by Rice, to approve Jones' request. Upon roll call: Selph, yes; Rice, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc File No 122143)

Jones and Jack Gordon from the Assessor's office were present to brief the Board on the CAMA software update. They presented quotes received from Boeckh Residential Software which detailed two options that are available to us. Quote
