Whereas, there has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, a petition with 10,96 signatures, which petition save for the signatures is in words and figures as follows to wit:

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma:

Sirs: Whereas, under and by authority of an act of the legislative assembly of the state of Oklahoma, approved March 20, 1909, entitled, An Act declaring section lines, public highways and prescribing method of opening highways for public use, making township boards, boards of highway commissioners, and prescribing their powers and duties; providing for the appointment of road supervisors and defining their powers and duties; providing for road duty and for levying tax for road and bridge purposes; providing for working county and state convicts upon the public highways; providing for the voluntary formation of road districts; for the construction of improving highways; authorizing counties and townships to issue bonds for road and bridge purposes; providing for the appointment of a county engineer and prescribing his powers and duties; repealing all laws conflicting with the provisions of this act, and declaring an emergency "the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma may, if authorized by the affirmative vote of $\frac{3}{5}$ of the voters cast at an election to be called for that purpose, issue its bonds to an amount not in excess of 20 per cent of the assessed valuation of said county, for the purpose of defraining and paying $\frac{1}{4}$ of the expense of improving the roads in the county within the boundaries of road districts formed or to be formed in said county; and

Whereas, before an election can be held for the purpose of submitting to the voters of said county, the question of the issuance of said bonds it is necessary that petitioners requesting that said election be called for said purpose be signed by 20 per cent of the qualified voters of the county, as shown by the last general election held in said county, be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of said county.

Now, Therefore we the undersigned qualified electors of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereby request that an election be called at an early date in said Tulsa County for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors thereof the question of authorizing the issuance by said county, of the negotiable coupon road bonds of said county to the aggregate amount of \$100,000.00, said bonds to be actually issued and delivered, however, as the money is needed to pay the county's portion of the expense of improving the roads in the road districts formed or to be formed in said county, all as provided by law.

Whereas, by reference to the registration lists of said county, and from other reliable sources, this board has ascertained and determined and hereby declare that each signature to said petition is the genuine and original signature of a qualified voter of said county, that the signature of said petition constitutes more than 20 per cent of the qualified voters of the county, as shown by the last
