

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

Monday, February 1st, 1915.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in their room at the County Court House at 11:00 A.M., Monday, February 1st, 1915, the following members present: C.S.Avery, A.W.Lucas, Ed. Baker. *Lewis Cline, Clerk County Court.*

A general discussion followed on various subjects.

The matter of the County printing was first taken up and it was moved by Mr. Baker, seconded by Mr. Lucas, that contract be made with the Democrat Printing Contract Co. on a basis of 15¢ per square for all county printing which the county is to pay for, same to be published only in the Weekly Democrat, with 10¢ additional to be paid for each publication of the Commissioners' proceedings in the Daily Democrat, County such publication in the Daily Democrat to be made at the direction of the Commissioners, and all printing for which the County does not pay, is to be paid for at the legal rate. Motion carried.

The following claims were audited and allowed: (See Claims)

No further business being brought before the Board, it was moved and seconded that the meeting be adjourned until 2:00 P.M.

At 2:00 P.M., Monday, February 1st, 1915, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened in their room at the Court House, all members present.

The Commissioners heard a verbal complaint from residents of District No. 1, of Jenks Twp., against the re-appointment of Mr. Sanford Smith as Road-overseer and the matter was carried over until next meeting of the Board when a further hearing of the matter can be had.

Complaint against Road-overseer, Dist No. 1, Jenks Twp. Repairing bridge in Willow Spgs Twp.

V.T.Jones was instructed by Mr. Baker to repair bridge on the one-half section line, Twp. 17, R. 14, Sec. No. 1, Willow Springs Twp.

The matter of the Kelly Gibson claim was discussed and the charge of 15% for extra help overseeing as Foreman's salary was deducted and the claim standing at \$715.60 was approved and allowed.

The R.E.Curran claim for salary, 1/6th of 75% of the total amount of assessment to be paid for the first six months and due Jan. 5, 1915, was discussed, approved and allowed.
