

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12th, 1940.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the salary of Bob Scott, Orderly at the Tulsa County Farm & Home, be increased from \$45.00 to \$50.00 per month as of September 1st, 1940. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Pass; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that the County Commissioners regretting the loss of the services of Sewell Skelton, Assistant Farm Demonstration Agent, and realizing the great loss to Tulsa County, but wishing to co-operate in the change, recommends the change and accepts the recommendation for the appointment of C. A. Wann to succeed Mr. Skelton, resigned as Assistant Farm Demonstration Agent of Tulsa County. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the County Commissioners sign with adjacent property owners application to vacate pedestrian way between Denver Place and Victoria Street in the Oak Cliff Addition, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.
