WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ofmOsage County met informally with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County in the Courthouse at Pawhuska, Oklahoma, on Saturday, September 22, 1928 and agreed to jointly participate in the construction of the aforementioned highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is jointly agreed between Osage and Tulsa Counties that Tulsa County will pay two thirds (2/3) of the cost of a Portland Cement Concrete Pavement and Osage County agrees to pay one third (1/3) of the cost of said Pavement.
