Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted. Cash Fund in the amount of \$3,598.87, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$5,908.69, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Emile Sterger, Clerk of Common Pleas Court, for the month of December, 1944, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, following vote was taken: Commissioner Greer, "AYE"; Commissioner Kinkaid, "AYE"; Commissioner Gray, "No." Chairman declared motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that upon the recommendation of Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, A. F. Jordan be appointed as Deputy Assessor to assess real and personal property in Collinsville Town and Township, to replace E. A. Patterson, at \$235.00 to complete the work. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that upon the recommendation of A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff of Tulsa County, George W. Way, of Sand Springs, be appointed as a Fee Deputy Sheriff said fees not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per year. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
