Instructions to electors

Time Election opened and closed

authorized to issue the negotiable coupon bonds for said County to the aggregate amount of \$400,000⁰⁰ for the purpose of paying the County's portion of improving the roads of said county in the Road Districts formed and to be formed therein, said bonds to be issued and delivered at such time and in such amounts as the money may be needed for said purpose, and levy and collect an annual tax upon all the taxable property in said county in addition to all other taxes sufficient to pay the interest on and principal of the bonds so issued when the same becomes due. Yes - No

An elector desiring to vote for the bond issue and tax levy shall stamp a cross (X) in the square in front of the word Yes and an elector desiring to vote against the bond issue and tax levy shall stamp a cross (X) in the square in front of the word "No".

Said election will be held at the polling places designated by the County Election Board for the holding of general elections in said Tulsa County, the same being the usual places for holding election therein which places are as follows, to wit:

The ballot to be used at said election will contain the proposition substantially in the form hereinafter set forth.

The polls at said election will be opened at the hour of eight O'clock in the forenoon and closed at the hour of six o'clock in the afternoon of said election day, except that in the city of Tulsa the polls will be opened at the hour of six O'clock in the forenoon and closed at the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon.

The said election will be conducted in the manner prescribed by the General Election Laws of the State of Oklahoma, and all persons possessing the qualifications prescribed by said laws and by the constitution of said state are entitled to vote at said election.
