That said Election Proclamations and notices shall be, and the same is hereby ordered published in two weekly newspapers published at the County Seat of said county, and of general circulation in said County, for four consecutive calendar weeks, the first of said publications to be not less than thirty days prior to the date fixed for said election.

Third: That the ballots for said election shall set forth the proposition to be voted upon substantially, in the form hereinbefore given, and the same shall be prepared, the said election held and conducted, the votes cast thereof counted, the results thereof returned, canvassed and certified as and in the manner prescribed by the General Election Laws of the State of Oklahoma.

Fourth: That this order and resolution, together with the proceedings of the Board relative thereto shall be published in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published and of general circulation in said Tulsa County.

Fifth: That the County Clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Election Board of said County, at the end of thirty days from its adoption and passage.

Sixth: That this resolution and order shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its adoption and passage. Passed and adopted this 10 day of August A. D. 1909.
