

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

Tuesday, February 2nd, 1915.

The Board of County Commissioners met in their room at the County Court House at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, February 2nd, 1915, all members present.

A general discussion of road work followed and all the various matters pertaining to same were taken under consideration.

Mr. Baker instructed Mr. Shimp to repair the roads in the lower part of Fry Twp. in road district No.3.

The question of better road supervision was talked over and it was moved by Mr. Avery and seconded by Mr. Lucas that each of the County Commissioners act for the particular locality in and near which he resided, that they employ men to drag the roads which are in condition to be drug, said work to be paid for according to the provisions of the law. Road overseers are to be appointed, whose duties it will be to make repairs and construct such roads as the County Commissioners may direct, said overseers to make weekly reports of each kind of work done, hours worked, locality and extent of the work, and mail same in to the County Engineer, he in turn to make report to the County Clerk, who will present same to the County Commissioners at their regular meeting.

Motion was made by Mr. Baker, seconded by Mr. Avery, that the County Clerk be instructed to check up all the books of the townships and demand that those townships which have not turned in their books, do so immediately.


