To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners,  
Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

We, the undersigned, respectfully petition you for an order permitting us to lay and install an eight inch sanitary sewer line along the east side of the open section line between Section 7, in Township 18 North, Range 13 East, and Section 12, in Township 18 North, Range 13 East, commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 7 and running south along the section line a distance of approximately ten hundred and sixty feet, more or less to the Arkansas River.

We desire this sewer to be installed along the east side of the section line, namely, in that part of the street twenty five feet wide, platted and dedicated to public use, as shown on the plats of the Valley Bend Sub Division and River Grove Subdivision, dedicated by Charles Stunkard and Mary Stunkard, his wife.

This sewer line is to be buried to an average depth of from six to ten feet. This sewer line is being built to accommodate the eighty acres known as the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 13 East. This land is located on the paved highway known as the Jenks Road, five miles south of Tulsa where the road turns east one mile.

WHEREAS, F F Reber, et al, has requested this Board to grant permission to said petitioners to establish a pole line carrying electric wires for power purposes in the County commencing at a point on the North intersection between Sections 2 and 3, Township 19, Range 12, and extending South on said Section line between Sections 10 and 11, 14 and 15, 22 and 23, 26 and 27, thence due East one mile between Sections 26 and 35. Beginning at the intersection of Section 27 and 34, and extending West a distance of three (3) miles between Sections 27 and 34, 28 and 33, and 29 and 32, all in Township 19 Range 12, Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said petition should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That permission be and it is hereby given to F F Reber, et al to construct, operate and maintain a pole line on the public highway in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at the location above set out.
