Now, on this 9th. day of March, 1931, the matter of he petition of MID-CONTINENT PETROLEUM CORPORATION for permission to lay a pipe line under, through and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said Mid-Continent Petroleum Corporation be permitted to use as much of the higheays as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description , which is as follows, to-wit:
