CONTRACT FOR THE INSTALLATIONS OF PNEUMATIC WATER SYSTEM.

This CONTRACT, executed in duplicate, made and entered into this 17th day of August, A. D. 1921, by and between Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and S. J. Campbell, a sole trader, whose place of business is at No. 1630 South Boston Street in the City of Tulsa, as follows, that is to say:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said county have heretofore advertised and invited bids for the purpose of installing a "Pneumatic Water System" at the County Farm, owned by said county, which said bids were publicly opened and read at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, held at the usual place of meeting of said Board at the County Court House, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 16th day of August, 1921, at which meeting all members of said Board of Commissioners were present; that upon due and full consideration of the bids so received the contract for installing of said "Pneumatic Water System" was awarded to S. J. Campbell on his bid of \$1035.00, the said Campbell agreeing to install said system complete as per specifications and plans drawn by M. C. Cross, which specifications and plans are made a part hereof as fully as if incorporated herein and set out at length.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of said sum of One Thousand and Thirty Five (\$1035.00) Dollars cash, to be paid at the time and in the manner hereinafter followings the said S. J. Campbell hereby agrees and obligates himself too erect, equip, and install complete the "Pneumatic Water System" known as and manufactured by the MILWAUKEE AIR POWER PUMP COMPANY at the point on the County Farm designated and selected by the Board of County Commissioners;

Said Campbell further agrees that the Water System in all detail will be installed, equipped and erected by him in workmanlike manner; that he possesses the particular knowledge and skill essential to the successful erection, installation and operation of such water system, and for the same donsideration, hereby obligates and binds himself to maintain said completed system in perfect operation for a period of one year from and after the date of the complete installation of said system and acceptance of same by the Board of County Commissioners on behalf of said county; that he will, upon request of said Board of County Commissioners or the Chairman thereof, upon demand make prompt repairs and correct any defect which may develop by reason of inherent or latent defects in said MILWAUKEE AIR POWER PUMP or in the workmanship or materials used and employed in and about the same during said time.

It is further understood and agreed, and for the same consideration hereinabove expressed, the Milwaukee Air Power Pump Company, as the manufacturers of said Air Power Pump System to be installed, undertakes to and does hereby guarantee the complete and perfect working and operation of said system as per letter of date August 19th, 1921, addressed to Mr. E. L. Wilson, Tulsa, Oklahoma, their local representative, which said letter is made a part hereof by reference, as fully as if incorporated herein, and set out at large.

Upon the complete installation of said Water System as aforesaid, together with the perfect operation of the same for a continuous period of hours to the satisfaction of said Board of County Commissioners, said S. J. Campbell shall then receive as payment in full for said completed system, work, labor xxx materials, cartage, etc., the sum of \$1035.00 and no more. In other words, said water system, when accepted by the Board of County Commissioners shall be free and clear of all liens, claims, or demands of any and all persons whomsoever, and receipted bills of every item connected with theurchase and construction of said water system small be
