WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 4th, 1939.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with the following members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray, Member, and Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Harry L. Hopkins, member, absent.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the County Court for the month of December, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a Quit Claim Deed to Howard S. Hatter on Lots 23 and 24, Block 4, Southside Addition to Sand Springs for the reason that said property was sold to the County in error; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of re-sale, and that the order selling said property to A. H. Burgess on the 28th day of December, 1938, be and the same is hereby rescinded and the deed ordered cancelled for the reason that said property did not belong to Tulsa County. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Cattle Brand filed by C. W. Jenni (39) be and the same is hereby approved. Motion carried.

John H. Miller deposited on January 3rd, 1939 with the County Treasurer \$89.00 collected from the operation of the colored municipal ~~kza~~ hospital. Same was ordered filed. Receipt #18266.

Hearing was had on the Bond of Ed Ward; said bond having been cancelled on January 3rd, 1939. Hearing was continued until Saturday, January 7th, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the bond filed by Charles Hugh Leaf, appointed Constable, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Motion carried.
