P E T I T I O N .

Comes now PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA, a corporation, and hereby shows to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that it has an electric light plant in the town of Coweta, Wagoner County, Oklahoma, equipped to furnish electric current to the citizens of Coweta, and that it has an electric light plant in the town of Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and an electric light plant at Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, from which it transmits electric current to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, all for furnishing electric current to the citizens of Broken Arrow, and adjoining territory and that said Public Service Company of Oklahoma desires to build, equip, establish and maintain a pole line on the public highway on the section road lying North of Sections 11 and 12, said line to commence at the intersection at the Northwest corner of Section 11, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, and running due east to the Wagoner County line, all situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in accordance with the attached map, for the purpose of conducting electric current over the same for furnishing current to the citizens of Coweta, Wagoner County, Oklahoma, and,

WHEREAS, in constructing and operating such pole line it will be necessary to build and maintain the same with wires thereon on the public highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, Public Service Company of Oklahoma hereby requests the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to permit the location of such pole line on the public highway on the section road lying North of Sections 11 and 12, said line to commence at the intersection at the Northwest corner of Section 11, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, and run due East to the Wagoner County line, all situated in Tulsa County Oklahoma. Said pole line to be erected in a substantial manner on the border of the highway in a manner that will not interfere with the use of said highway for public travel or any other use of said highway, and further requests that said Board make such additional and further orders in the premises as may be necessary herein.

THEREUPON, Commissioner W.L. North, offers the following resolution and moves its adoption:

WHEREAS, Public Service Company of Oklahoma has requested this Board to grant permission to said Company to establish a pole line carrying electric wires for power purposes in this County, on the section road lying North of Sections 11 and 12, said line to commence at the intersection at the Northwest corner of Section 11, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, and run due East to the Wagoner County line, all situated in Tulsa County Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said petition be granted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that permission be and it is hereby given to the Public Service Company of Oklahoma to construct, operate and maintain a pole line on the public highway in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at the location described as follows, to-wit:

On the Section road lying North of Sections 11 and 12, said line to commence at the intersection at the Northwest corner of Section 11, Township 18 North Range 14, East, and run due East to the Wagoner County line, all situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

and, to carry on said pole line wires for conveying electric current of any voltage desired by said Company, said line to be substantially constructed and properly maintained, at the border of said highway in such manner as not to interfere with public travel or the use of said highway.

Which motion was seconded, voted upon with the following result:
