

THURSDAY, MAY 1, 1947

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. William P. Gable, Jr., County Clerk.


J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, that the Board follow the first recommendation of the School Board and ear-mark \$650,000.00 for the construction of the Booker T. Washington High School, and that this money be put out on interest for two years. Chairman declared motion lost for want of a second.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Board follow the advice of the School Board and the Negro Citizens Committee, and ear-mark the balance of \$1,000,000.00 for the Booker T. Washington High School after all expenses have been paid; and that <sup>be</sup>\$50,000.00 /taken out for the improvement of the City Separate Schools and <sup>be</sup>\$22,500.00 /taken out for the improvement of the County Separate Schools. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Gray, Aye; Commissioner Greer, Nay; Commissioner Bailey, Aye. Chairman declared motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of the School Board and the Negro Citizens Committee that all bids received on the construction and erection of the Booker T. Washington High School <sup>be rejected</sup> /at this time. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until Monday, May 5, 1947, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. Motion carried.
