The Board of County Commissioners reconvened pursuant to recess heretofore taken at the hour of 1:30 O'Clock P., with all Members present: John H Miller, Chairman, J B Gray and H E Bridges, Members.

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had:

In the matter of the laying of Pipe line across, through and under certain highways by the GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, the following Order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this 14th. day of August, 1933, the matter of the Petition of GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation, for permission to lay a four inch welded pipe line, along, under and across certain highways in said County and State, came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board, and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point within the highway in the intersection of 61st. Street (West Avenue) and 23rd. Street, in West Tulsa View Acres, in the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and extending West along the North side of 23rd. Street 1,365 feet.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, By the Board of County Commissioners of said County, that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

COMES NOW, Great Lakes Pipe Line Company, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maryland, with offices in Kansas City, Missouri, and doing business in the State of Oklahoma, and hereby petitions your Honorable Board for the right to lay a four inch, welded pipe line under, through and across certain highways, as shown by accompanying plat, and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 625 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma., and extending west along the south side of 21st. Street 735 feet.

PETITIONER AGREES THAT said pipe line will be so constructed so as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

Beginning at a point 495 feet west and 790 feet North of the Southeast corner of Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; thence South 136 degrees, 24 minutes west 216 feet, thence south 104
