lump sum payment of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00);

(b) Upon the award of the construction contract to the successful bidder a sum equal to three per cent (3%) of the contract cost of construction, determined as set forth in Section 4, less the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) being the payment for preliminary work; provided, that if no contract is awarded within three (3) months after the completion of the plans and specifications by the second party, and the delivery of same to the first party, the first party shall pay to the second party a sum equal to three (3%) per cent of the estimated construction cost, less the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00).

SECTION 6. In the event of the death or disability of any of the individuals composing the second party to this contract, this contract shall remain in full force and effect between the County and the remaining individuals composing the second party.
