IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the said lands as above designated.


