Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Laura S. Rudisell covering realestate for the years 1930, 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved 60% off the assessed valuation, and the County Clerk is directed to issue a Certificate of Error covering same, provided, however, that the Certificate of Error shall not be issued until the expiration of twenty days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said Certificate of Error shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said twenty days until the issue of said protest is determined. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Miller, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that G. W. Quigley, be and he is hereby appointed poultryman at the County Farm & Home, as of April 1st, 1938, at a salary of \$80.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
