MINUTES  
THURSDAY, JULY 10, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: John Selph, Chairman; Melvin C. Rice, Member; and Lewis Harris, Member. Members absent: None. Others present: Clayton Edwards, Susan Morgan, and Melody Bishop.

John Selph, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order and the following business was transacted:

The Board discussed A.G. Opinion 85-180 pertaining to requirements of counties to bid the purchase of computer hardware and/or software (assuming none of the statutory exemptions apply). Leroy Jones stated Tulsa County is in compliance.

Leroy Jones and Lt. Duff were present to discuss the proposed changes of the Sheriff's Management System. The Board instructed Jones to proceed with the changes. Chairman to write a letter of thanks to the Dallas County Sheriff's office.
