The polls of said election will be opened at 7 O'clock A.M. and closed at 6 O'clock P.M. on said election day.

All qualified electors in said county are entitled to vote at said election.

Said election proclamation and notice shall be published in a weekly newspaper published and of general circulation in said Tulsa County for four consecutive calendar weeks.

Section 3. The ballots for said election shall be prepared by the county clerk substantially in the form herein above set forth, and said election shall be held at the places designated by the county election board for the holding of general elections in said county and which are the usual places for holding elections therein, being the places herein above set forth, and shall be conducted, the result thereof certified, canvassed and recorded as in the act mentioned in the preamble here prescribed.

Section 4. This resolution and order shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption and passage.

Section 5. This order and resolution, together with the proceeding of the board shall be published in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published and of general circulation in said Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
