

Copy of Order Granted to Alpine Oil Co.

township line running north and south between townships 12 and 13 East at the southeast corner of what is known as the Emma Alberty allotment, being the SE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ of section 13, Township 20, Range 12 East; thence running south on said township line one-half mile to the intersection of said township line with the section line running east and west between sections 18 and 19, Township 20, Range 13; thence across said Township line; thence East along said section line, between said section 18 and 19, for a distance of about three eighths of a mile, to the Northeast corner of a ten-acre tract, allotted upon by Naomi Wilson, being described as the NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of section 19, Township 20, Range 13.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be buried so as not to interfere with ingress or egress to adjacent farms at the ordinary places of entrance and at such other places along such highways when the abutting land owners may desire to locate a place for entrance when so requested by said owner.

It is understood that in granting this order that it shall in no way be construed as assuming any responsibility on the part of the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County or on ^{the} part of said county but The Alpine Oil Company shall be responsible for all damages done in constructing said lines of pipe, or which in any wise may be caused or occasioned thereby or by the use of the same hereafter.

It is further understood and agreed that said lines of pipe shall be used only for the transportation of water. It is further understood that this order and the rights secured and granted thereby shall in no wise abridge the right and authority of the County Commissioners, the township trustees and the Road Overseers of the public highways in said county as the same is now provided by law.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be so laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the use of any of the public highways nor the repairs thereof.

When said lines parallel section lines it shall be laid and constructed as near the outside line of the highways as possible, and in no case shall said company encroach on the inside line of the highway more than three feet without first getting permission from County Commissioner so to do, that is to say, when said line runs parallel to section lines.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the drainage of the highways, and in crossing drains or streams shall be placed above or below the same so as not to obstruct the flow of water therein.
