

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 1st, 1941.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Andy Stokes, County Clerk, for the month of October, 1941, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of Betty Snell as Assistant Probation Officer at a salary of \$75.00 per month as of October 16th, 1941, as made by Judge James P. Melone, to take the place of Ruth Hughes, be and the same is hereby confirmed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Depository Agreement between The Citizens Morris Plan State Bank and the Board of County Commissioners, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Fred Netherton be appointed Boiler Engineer at the Courthouse for five months beginning October 1st, 1941, at a salary of \$100.00 per month.
