On motion of Board the Arkansas Valley State Bank's bid was accepted and County Treasurer was instructed to place \$10,000⁰⁰ of County's funds in said bank for a period of 6 months.

On motion of Board Bank of Birby was authorized to make depository bond that County Funds may be placed therein.

On motion of Board Drainage District no 1 was named Fry District.

The appointment of J. A. Mote as a member of the Board of County Examiners was on motion of Board approved.

On motion of Board The Tulsa Street Railway was granted the use of certain highways for the use of railway. The matter of Road Petitions of Township Board of Lynn Lane township same was granted and the following viewers were appointed: Guy Brewer, W. C. Stone and John Kramer to meet on the 29th day of Sept., 1909, to view and lay out said road. On motion of Board
