which are regularly and lawfully due, providing that no penalty shall attach by reason of the taxes not having been paid, and

Be it further resolved that any sales which may have taken place, that the certificates be called in and paid off and cancelled now in the hands of parties other than Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

The motion was then by the Chairman put to a vote, and all members voting in the affirmative the same was by the Chairman declared carried.

Upon motion of F. M. Wooden seconded by Ira Short that \$950.00 of the valuation of the personal property of Mrs. Ed Faris for the year 1920 be stricken from the tax rolls, also that \$49,400.00 be stricken from the personal property of the Producers Supply Company on application of Sam Miller for the year 1920. Motion carried.
