WHEREAS, it appears from said petition that same should be granted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that permission be and it is hereby given to the Public Service Company of Oklahoma to construct, operate and maintain a pole line on the public highway in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at the location described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the north line of the city limits of the Town of Owasso, Oklahoma, and 21 ft. west of the center of paved road and running north parallel with and 21 ft west of the center of pavement to a point 21 ft. south of the north line of Sec. 30, T 21 N., R 14 E., thence east parallel with and 21 ft. south of the north line of Sec. 30, T. 21 N., R 14 E., to a point 21 ft. east and 21 ft. south of the NW corner of Sec. 29, T 21 N., R 14 E., thence north parallel with and 21 ft. east of the center of pavement, a distance of approximately 4 1/2 miles, thence in a northeasterly direction parallel with pavement and 21 ft southeast of center of pavement, to where pavement crosses Santa Fe Railroad.

Also, beginning at a point 21 ft. east and 21 ft. north of the SW corner of Sec 5, T 21 N., R 14 E., and running east parallel with and 21 ft. north of the south line of Sec 5, T 21 N., R 14 E., a distance of 6/10 mile. All in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

and to carry on said pole line wires for conveying electric current of any voltage desired by said Company, said line to be substantially constructed and properly maintained at the border of said highway in such manner as not to interfere with public travel or the use of said highway.
