

repairing or removing of its water mains and other equipment for said project and shall have the right to conduct all such operations in and over and under said streets, alleys, public highways and public places in said District as may be necessary or proper for the said project and to permanently occupy such parts of the ground under said streets, alleys and public highways and grounds as may be necessary for said project and shall further have the right to install in such places as shall not interfere with public travel, all meters, hydrants and other equipment as may be reasonably necessary for the construction and maintenance of said project.

As a consideration for this grant and as a condition thereof it is provided and agreed by the Sand Springs Home and it will indemnify and save harmless the County of Tulsa from any and all damage and claim for damage which may accrue by reason of the use of said streets, alleys and public highways and public places by it; and that it will properly protect its excavation and other structures during the progress of its work in such manner as not to endanger life or property and that it will in all respects during the progress of construction and during maintenance of the project comply with all road laws and other applicable laws of the State of Oklahoma.

It is further expressly provided and agreed by the Sand Springs Home that it will replace all earth and excavated material and leave the surface of the streets, alleys, public highways and public places in as good condition after the laying of its mains as it was before such operations and that it will at its own expense remove all surplus excavated earth and other material remaining after the completion of the work and that it will leave such streets, alleys and public highways and public places in a good condition for public use.

Said resolution having received the unanimous vote of the Commission was adopted.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Shaver that the reports of audits, as presented by Ed O. Cassidy, Special Deputy State Examiner and Inspector, on Cases numbered 8574, 9478, 8576, 9479, 8575, 9480, 30708 and 32083 respectively, be and the same are hereby approved. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Shaver, that Claim No. 111360 favor of E Ray, be approved notwithstanding that it has not been approved by Mr. Cassidy, Special Deputy State Examiner and Inspector. Carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Shaver, seconded by Mr. North, that Claim No. 111328 be and the same is hereby disallowed for the reason that same has been paid to the Sheriff. Carried.

There being nothing further coming on for consideration, the meeting is hereby adjourned until Monday, June 7th. 1926.
