Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with the following members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray, Member; Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Harry L. Hopkins, Member, absent.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the bond filed by J. Tom Bailey, Justice of the Peace, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company, for a period beginning January 2nd, 1939 and ending January 6th, 1941, be and the same is hereby approved.
