## R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, Dawson Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 6th day of September, 1921, be a vote of its qualified voters, did authorize the issuance by the Board of County Commissioners, acting as and in the capacity of the Township Board as provided by law, bonds in the sum of \$250,000.00 for the purpose of grading draining and otherwise improving certain public highways within said township, such highways being designated in the resolution providing for such election, and

WHEREAS, before an accurate estimate of the cost of improving said highways can be arrived at, it is necessary that surveys, profiles, plans, specifications and estimates therefrom be compiled by the County Engineer of Tulsa County,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Engineer of Tulsa County, be directed to make such surveys as may be necessary, making appropriate plans and profiles thereof, and prepare specifications and estimates and all details necessary, and when the same are completed, to present the same to this Board for examination and approval, and to the State Department of Highways for approval as provided by law.
