The resignations of H. D. Lindsey, Constable, Red Fork Township was read and on motion accepted.

H. L. Rose was on motion of Board appointed constable of Red Fork Township and his bond was approved.

On motion of Board the bid of The Columbia Bank and Trust Co. for bonds of Fry Drainage District No. 1. was accepted as per their letter of Sept. 7, 1909 for \$25,000.00 or such part as shall be needed to meet any unpaid balance of the amount so levied against such tracts of land in said District. In the matter of the Erroneous Assessment of Thomas Gilchrist it was ordered on motion of Board that the taxes be stricken from the roll on the homestead of his allotment for the amount of \$230<sup>75</sup>.

In the matter of the taxes on homestead of Albert Perryman same was ordered stricken from the roll the amount of \$4<sup>97</sup>.

In the matter of the taxes on the homestead of Henry W. Perryman same was ordered stricken from the rolls. In the matter of A. B. Linnis it was shown that the property in question was not assessable for the year 1908 and same was ordered stricken from rolls. In the matter of Mary Miller it was shown that her homestead was not assessable for the year 1908, and the same was ordered stricken from the rolls.

On motion of Board W. J. Crumbaugh was given the right to put up mile posts on the side of the roads in Tulsa County. Commissioners adjourned.
