MONDAY, JANUARY 16th, 1939.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, January 16th, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that F. O. Whitley be appointed special deputy Sheriff to serve process in the Court of Harry Hamilton, Justice of the Peace in District No. 3, Tulsa County, Oklahoma. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bond filed by Andy Newell, Appointed Constable in District No. 11, Division 2, in the amount of \$1,000, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the bond filed by R. L. Jones, elected Constable in District No. 7, in the amount of \$1,000, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the annual report filed by the Tulsa State Fair for the period beginning January 1, 1938 and ending December 31, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the annual report filed by A. F. Ezzell, Tulsa County Live Stock & Meat Inspector, covering anti-mortem, post mortem and re-inspection report of all packing houses, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
