County Farm Matters. Commissioners met at their office at 1:30 P. M., after which they in company with Dr. Earnhart, County Farm Demonstrator and R. K. Hughes, County Engineer, visited the County Home, and made recommendation as to the future handling of same, after which they convened at their office in the Court House and proceeded with the days business.

Erroneous assmnts. of C. J. Wrightsman being represented by Mr. C. C. Herndon. The matter was contested by Mr. F. M. Sutton. 1908 taxes stricken on account of being erroneously assessed 1911-12-13 referred to the County Attorney for further consideration, and was accepted by Mr. F. M. Sutton, and warrant drawn on the sinking fund #61.

Proposition of Arthur Farmer. The proposition of Mr. Arthur Farmer, was submitted to the Board, to compare the transcribed records in the Registers of Deeds office. The proposition being, to take two people to compare the above records, and to be supervised by Mr. Farmer; said Mr. Farmer to draw a salary for the actual time consumed and expenses. The entire cost estimated at about \$200.00 per month/ The matter was postponed until a future meeting.

Dawson Twp. Road. The next matter taken up, was a petition signed by Mr. W. O. Dickenson, W. H. Chism and Ed. Hedgecock, for opening up a road along the Frisco Right-Of-way, east to the town of Dawson, for which deeds have been filed with the County Clerk. A resolution was passed by the County Commissioners that said deeds be accepted and the right-of-way be paid for, as the amounts appear in said deeds, and the County Engineer be instructed to at once open up said highway for public travel.

Resgn. of Dr. Rhoades & Appt. of Dr. Brodie. Dr. Rhoades having resigned as County Physician, Dr. W. W. Brodie, was this day appointed to position of County Physician at \$135.00 per month.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned until 7:30 P. M.

Appt. of Tick Erad-icators. At 7:30 P. M., the appointment of Tick Eradicators was taken up and W. L. Defries of Bixby, was appointed to receive \$5.00 per day, for all days worked during the time of his appointment. J. F. Hawkins of Lynn-Lane Township was appointed Tick Eradicator at \$5.00 per day for all time worked during the life of his appointment.

Road Matters. An order was made by the Board of County Commissioners, that all Road Supervisors shall send their time to the County Engineer, and he to fill out all claims and to file same with the County Clerk. The County Clerk was instructed to notify all Townships Roadoverseers, that their pay for road work be \$2.00 per day.

Canceled Tax Sale Certificate. It was ordered that the County Treasurer, be instructed to cancel warrant No's. 7450 for the year 1912; and No. 19427 for the year of 1913, and collect same without penalty.

Order of R. K. Hughes. An order was made by the Board of County Commissioners, that R. K. Hughes be given authority to give requisitions for materials in his line of work/

Canceled Tax Sale. An order was also made to John T. Kramer, County Treasurer, to cancel tax sale certificate on block nineteen (19), Midland Addition to Bixby, and all penalties be remitted for erroneous sale of said block for the year of 1912.

Erroneous Assmnt. The erroneous assessment of Mr. J. Benninghoff was ordered by the County Commissioners, that alias warrant #3411 be canceled and penalties remitted and assessments lowered from \$470.00 to \$235.00, which amount is paid to the County Treasurer.

There being no further business before the Board, they adjourned until Thursday, April 15th, 1915.
