MONDAY, MAY 12, 1947

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. William P. Gable, Jr., County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of M. L. Brown, Justice of the Peace in and for District 11, Tulsa County, as of May 12, 1947, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that M. S. Simms be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace in and for District 11, Tulsa County, replacing M. L. Brown who resigned. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the bond filed by Matthew S. Simms, Justice of the Peace in and for District 11, Tulsa County, in the amount of \$1,000.00 and made by the National Surety Corporation, New York, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of A. F. Parker as a Deputy Sheriff, effective May 8, 1947, at a salary of \$175.00 per month, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that Commissioner Gray sign the County Deed issued to Minnie Thurman, covering Lots 1, 2, 3 and East 75 feet of Lot 4, Block 40, original Townsite of Collinsville, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as the original deed issued January 2, 1934 was lost and never recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the following affidavits of erroneous assessment filed and approved by Garrett Newman, County Assessor, and approved by Hugh Webster, Assistant County Attorney, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue certificates of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried:
