Be It Resolved And Ordered,

by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, and the state of Oklahoma, that the resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 10 day of July 1909, entitled: "A resolution and order providing for the calling and holding of an election in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 12 day of October Ad. 1909, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters thereof the proposition of said county expending the sum of \$100,000⁰⁰, or so much thereof as may be needed to pay the county's portion of the expense of improving the roads in said county as and in the manner provided by law, and issuing its negotiable coupon bonds in said amount for said purpose of levying and collecting an annual tax upon all of the taxable property in said county in addition to all other taxes sufficient to pay the interest and principal of said road bonds when due" be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

The title of said resolution shall be amended by changing the date therein given from the 12 day of Oct. 1909 to the 19 day of October, 1909.

Section 1 of said resolution shall be, and the same is hereby amended by changing the date of the election thereby called from the 12 day of Oct. 1909 to the 19 day of October 1909.

That the form of Proclamation as set forth in said resolution be, and the same is hereby amended by changing the date for the holding of said election from the 12 day of October 1909, to the 19 day of October 1909.

Whereas, the public roads in the County of Tulsa, and in the road districts therein, are in a condition that it makes travel thereon dangerous to the health and safety of the inhabitants thereof by reason of which it is necessary that the bonds of said county be immediately voted for the purpose of building, grading and repairing same, be it resolved that an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof it is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this resolution become effective immediately from and after its passage and approval.
