A motion was made by R.A.Martin and seconded by C.E. Suppes that the County Engineer be instructed to make an estimate of the approach to Bridge and the complete said work at once.

The following resolution was adopted by the Board and signed.

MAINTENANCE RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma to provide the best pessible system of maintenance for the state road system of Tulsa County, and

WHEREAS, It is our opinion that we have full authority under the statutes of this state to establish and maintain a separate maintenance department for the care and maintenance of these roads

Therefore, be it resolved that there is hereby created in the county a maintenance separate and distinct department to be known as the State Highway department of Tulsa County.

This department shall be under the direction and control of the county engineer, who in addition to his duties as county highway engineer is hereby designated and appointed as superintendent of this department and in consideration of his services in such capacity he shall be paid the sum of per month in addition to whatever salary he may be entitled to under haw as county highway engineer.

The said county superintendent of the maintenance department as herein designnated is hereby authorized to divide the state highway system of the county into such number of maintenance sections as in his judgement may be necessary for the purpose of best carrying into effect this resolution and he is hereby further authorized to expend out of the county road maintenance fund sauch sums of maney as in his judgment may be necessary, provided however that such sums shall not exceed the sum of \$25.00 per mile per month.

Subject only to this limitation the said county superintendent of the maintenance department is hereby authorized to employ and discharge labor and to do and perform any and all acts relating to the proper maintenance of said state highway system that are not inconsistent with the laws of the state of Oklahoma governing such work.

The tenure of this department shall be for such length of time as in the judgment of the board it is wise, and to the best advantage of the county to maintain the same and it shall be effective from and after the 15th day of May 1918, until such timeas this order shall be revolked by resolution of the board.

It shall be the duty of the county superintendent of maintenance to submit to the board on the first Monday in each month a written report of his work and a detailed statement of his expenditures for the preceding month and such reports shall be filed with the County Clerk and become a part of the records of his office.
