R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of Independent District No. 1, Tulsa, Oklahoma, has requested the Board of County Commissioners to transfer to said School District the balance of Separate School Bond Funds to which it may be entitled, for use by said School District in the permanent improvement of the Separate Schools of Tulsa County in said District, as provided by Law; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be \$17,000.00 balance of unencumbered funds of the County Separate School Improvement Bond issues of 1946 and 1948, which may be so transferred as provided by Section 13, Article 15 of House Bill 120 of the 1949 Oklahoma Legislature (1949 S.L. p 570);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Clerk and County Treasurer be, and they each are hereby authorized, empowered and directed in manner provided by law, to transfer and deliver to the Treasurer of Independent School District No. 1, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the balance of unencumbered funds of the County Separate School Improvement Bond issues of 1946 and 1948, in the sum of 17,000.00, as provided by House Bill 120.
