

A resolution amending a resolution

Whereupon Commissioner Cleland introduced a resolution and order entitled:
 "A resolution amending a resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 10th day of July, 1909, entitled, "A resolution and order, providing for the calling and holding of an election in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 12th day of October A.D. 1909, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters thereof the several propositions of the said county expending the sum of \$200,000⁰⁰ and issuing its negotiable coupon bonds in said amount, for the construction of a court house in and for said county, and the proposition of submitting to the qualified voters thereof of said Tulsa County expending the sum of \$25,000⁰⁰ for jail in and for said county, and of levying and collecting an annual tax upon all the taxable property in said county, in addition to all other taxes sufficient to pay the interest on and principal of said court house and jail bonds when due", which resolution was read in full by the clerk.

Moved by Cleland, seconded by Mc Keehan, that said resolution and order be adopted and passed as read.

The question being put to vote, the roll was called with the following results.

Those voting "Aye" Cleland, Mc Keehan & North. Those voting "No", None.

And the motion was by the chairman declared carried and the foregoing resolution and order adopted.

Whereupon Commissioner Cleland moved that section 2 setting forth the emergency nature of the resolution be passed as read. Motion seconded by Mc Keehan.

Whereupon being put by the chairman the vote resulted as follows:
