IN THE MATTER OF THE CNSTRUCTION BY PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY
OF OKLAHOMA, OF AN ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE FROM TULSA,
OKLAHOMA, EAST TO THE OKLAHOMA-ARKANSAS LINE.

COMES NOW, Public Service Company of Uklahoma, a corporation, and shows to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Uklahoma, that it is a corporation, organized existing and doing business under and by virtue of, and characterized by the laws of the State of Oklahoma as a public utility, engaged in the production, distribution and sale of electric current and energy for light, and power purposes, to and for the citizens and light and power consumers of the State of Oklahoma; and in due course of its said business, desires to build, equip, maintain and operate a line of poles, wires and fixtures (to be located in part upon, along and across the public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma) to inter-connect its power station located at Tulsa, Oklahoma, with the lines and power stations of the Southwestern Gas & Electric Company near Forest Park, Arkansas, the route of said line thru Tulsa County, being described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the East Bank of the Arkansas River 24 feet north of the East and west half section line of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, thence running east over private lands to a point 24 feet north of the west quarter corner of section 21, township 19 north, Range 13 east; thence along the public highway running east and west along the south line of Blocks 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46 and 47 of Albert Pike Sub-Division of the E½ NW¼ and SW¼ NW¼ of said Section 21, to a point 24 feet north of the southwest corner of Block 48 of said Sub-Division; and thence east over private lands to a point 11 feet south of the east quarter corner of Section 24, township 19 North, Range 14 East on the Tulsa-Wagoner County Line, crossing intervening north and south section lines at points respectively located as follows: 24 feet north of the respective west quarter corners of sections 19, 20, 21 and 22 Township 19 North, Range 13 East, and 11 feet
North of the respective west quarter corners of Sections 23 and 24, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, and Sections 19, 20, 21 and 22 and 23, Township 19 North, Range 14 East, and 11 feet south of the east and west quarter corners of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 14 East, Township 19 North,

that said line will be constructed and maintained in conformity to the regulations and orders of your Honorable Board, and in such a manneras will not interfere with present or future use of said highways ofr public travel or other proper use.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, your petitioner respectfully prays that your Honorable Board authorize and permit the construction, maintenance and operation of said pole line. upon over and across the public highways above described, and make such orders as may be necessary and proper herein.
