We have before us Purchase Order No. 18161 in the amount of \$698.47 to be charged to the County Highway Levy Budget Account No. 14. Motion by <sup>Commissioner</sup>Mr. Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the above Purchase Order be approved in the amount of \$698.47. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

We have before us Purchase Order No. 18162 in the amount of \$698.46 to be charged to the County Highway Levy Budget Account No. 25. Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the above purchase order in the amount of \$698.46 be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the County Clerk, be and he is hereby directed to charge each of the above listed Purchase Orders against the appropriation accounts as enumerated on each of the purchase orders. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

We are informed by the County Highway Department that they have on hand a number of purchase orders issued prior to Order No. 18162 and also bearing numbers smaller than No. 18162 which it has been impossible to enter on the encumbrance record of the County Clerk and the Board of County Commissioners at this time approve each of said purchase orders and order and direct the County Clerk to enter said orders against the appropriation accounts as enumerated on each of said orders. All of said orders for purchases made prior to the close of business June 30th, 1943. Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the above be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the following Resolution be adopted. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Gray, Aye; Morley, Aye; Greer, Aye. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 1942-43 will officially end with the close of business on Wednesday, June 30th, 1943, and

WHEREAS, an unencumbered balance of appropriation will at this time by action of law automatically lapse, and

WHEREAS, there is now on file with the County Clerk various claims, invoices, orders, etc., representative of an indebtedness for salaries, wages, materials, supplies and equipment, pending action and approval for payment at the regular meeting of the Board of the County Commissioners, for the allowance of claims beginning on the first Monday in July, 1943, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has not officially acknowledged, accepted and ratified all of said claims, invoices, orders, etc., now on file with the County, and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk is without authority to show encumbrances against an appropriation without authorization by a bonded officer or the Board of County Commissioners, the purchasing agents of the County as designated by statute, and
