RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, desire to have an examination of the books and accounts of the various officials of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, made by and under the direction of the State Examiner and Inspector of the State of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Examiner and Inspector of the State of Oklahoma, be requested to assign a deputy State Examiner and Inspector under the authority of Section 3727, O.S. 1931 to make such examination aforesaid, and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that such deputy State Examiner and Inspector assigned to perform said duties shall receive as compensation the sum of \$200.00 per month for one month beginning July 12th and ending August 12th, 1936, and expenses not to exceed \$4.00 per day.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that there be included in the Estimate of Needs for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1937, sufficient appropriation to adequately provide for said salary and expense of such deputy State Examiner and Inspector.

Upon motion by Commr. Gray, duly seconded by Commr. Hopkins, the above Resolution is hereby adopted.
