MONDAY, JUNE 29, 1987

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County met at the hour of 9:30 a.m. with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman Pro-tem; John Selph, Member; and Joan Hastings, County Clerk. Melvin C. Rice, Chairman, was absent.

Lewis Harris, Chairman Pro-tem, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

Proclamation was read proclaiming the month of July, 1987 as National Park and Recreation Month.

Moved by Harris, seconded by Selph, to approve the minutes of June 22, 1987. Upon roll call, Selph, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried.
