Scott Orbison, Secretary of the Election Board addressed the Board on possible reorganization of the Election Board. He presented an outlay detailing the plans. Selph requested copies of old organization charts. Rice suggested checking with Terry Tallent to see if Orbison's recommendation is in line with the rest of the County. Tallent is to do four job studies a month to develop new job descriptions and Joan Hasting's office will provide length of service of all employees at the Election Board.

Gary Cox, representing the City-County Health Department, requested permission of the Board to sell the property at 2828 West 51st Street currently occupied by the John Tomblin Health Center. Title to this property is held by the Board of County Commissioners. The District Attorney's office and Cox are to prepare documents for action by the BOCC which would declare the property to be surplus to the needs of the County.

Rich Brierre and Claudia Ellingsworth briefed the Board on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application for FY-89. INCOG recommends that Tulsa County apply for FY-89 CDBG funds. Chairman asked Brierre to recommend specific projects: Selph suggested if we have projects we should pass them on to Brierre and Ellingsworth and requested they come back to the Board with their recommendations by the end of June.
