

the parties hereto not later however, than 45 days from this date. Bids for the said work to be received, opened and considered by the parties hereto in the City of Tulsa, such proposals to be submitted on form to be prepared by the County Engineer of Tulsa County and the Chief Engineer of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railroad Company, and it shall be provided that such proposals may be submitted separately and jointly for the work to be done off the right of way and on the right of way, and it is further provided that upon the award of a contract the parties hereto shall separately enter into contract with the successful bidder for the respective work which each party is to do and perform according to the terms of the above agreement.

It is further understood that all work necessary on the railroad right of way will be done at this time and that when it becomes necessary in order to adequately take care of the traffic to completely open the double 20 foot undercrossing, that the railroad company will not be called upon to bear any further expenses in connection therewith, and that an order in agreed form will be drawn to be submitted by the County Commissioners and the Railroad Company to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission to be entered in the case now pending before the Corporation Commission, covering the construction of the undercrossing at Fifteenth Street.

To all of the provisions set out above the parties hereto jointly and severally agree.
