R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, both the Oklahoma State Highway C mmission and Tulsa County are desirous of disposing of the old Arkansas River Bridge at Sand Springs, and

WHEREAS, the State has under consideration a proposition for its disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County do hereby release to the State Highway Department of Oklahoma, any and all claims to what is known as the old steel span Arkansas River Bridge at Sand Springs; disposition of same to be made by the State Highway Department as they see fit, except one (1) span to be left in place on the North end of Bridge.

All Members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried and Resolution adopted.

The following Resolution was introduced by Mr.Hedgecock, who moved its adoption, said motion being seconded by Mr.Dickey, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, a change has been made in alignment of road through Smelter Property at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, to meet the new alignment, a grade crossing is necessary across the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad on W, lson Street approximately one block West of the present crossing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad Company be requested to close the present grade crossing at Cleveland Street and open a new crossing at Wilson Street.

All members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried and Resolution adopted.

The Following Resolution was introduced by Mr.Hedgecock, who moved its adoption, said motion being seconded by Mr.Dickey, and the Chairman odered the same read:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, a Petition having been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County by residents and property owners in Sections 24 and 25, Township 18 N., R 12 E., requesting the opening of a road, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board that a necessity for such road does exist, and it further appearing that such petition be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners do hereby authorize and instruct the County Engineer to proceed with the opening and making ready for travel the following described location:

#The East one-half (E½) mile of the Section Line
between Sections Twenty Four (24) and Twenty Five
(25), Township Eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve
(12), East Tulsa County Oklahoma.
