On motion of Board the Bond of F. O. Brown, Trustee, Red Fork Township was approved. In the matter of N. Y. Arnold vs. J. W. Patston asking for rebate on taxes same was granted and amount asked for relief stricken from Tax Rolls on motion of Board. The County Clerk was instructed to hold warrant of Hillman and Kramer Contractors until receipts for materials were filed with clerk on motion of Board. The following Resolution and contract was approved.

Whereas, the County's progress and intelligence is judged by the attention given its worthy poor and unfortunate sick; and

Whereas, it has become necessary for the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to provide attention, nursing and medical care for its worthy poor and those who are unable to provide such services for themselves; and

Whereas, we do not deem it advisable for the County to build and maintain the hospital at its own expense for such purposes, at present; and,

Whereas, a private hospital has been erected, equipped and is maintained by the Tulsa Hospital Association, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Indian Territory, (now Oklahoma), and whose plant and equipment is owned by the officers and property holders in the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and,

Whereas, the health of the County may be in part safe guarded by the proper and intelligent care of a contagious disease known as Typhoid Fever, which, if not cared for in a sanitary manner, may contaminate an entire County by the distribution of its germs, due to improper nursing;

Therefore, in keeping with the great obligations imposed by an advanced civilization, and for the purpose of conserving the public health by giving proper care to worthy and dependent sick and injured.

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the following contract and agreement with the Tulsa Hospital Association be and is hereby authorized and executed:
