A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ROAD BONDS IN THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS FOR DAWSON TOWNSHIP, TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZED AT AN ELECTION DULY CALLED AND HELD FOR SUCH PURPOSE, PRESCRIBING FORM OF BONDS, PROVIDING LEVY FOR PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON THE SAME, AND FIXING OTHER DETAILS OF THE ISSUE.

Whereas, on the 6th day of September, 1921, pursuant to notice duly given and election was held in Dawson Township, Tulsa County, State of Oklaoma, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said township, the question of the issuance of bonds of said township, in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of providing funds for the purpose of improving roads in said township by draining, grading, gravelling and macadamizing the same, and:

Whereas, as shown by the canvass of the county election Board at said Election 669 votes were cast ~~for the issuance of said bonds~~, 183 votes were cast against the issuance of said bonds, 476 votes were cast for the issuance of said bonds, and no mutilated ballots were cast, the number of votes case for the issuance of said bonds being more than three fifths of all the votes cast on said proposition, the issuance of the bonds has been duly authorized, Now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

Section 1: That there are hereby ordered and directed to be issued the negotiable coupon bonds of Dawson Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in accordance with the form as hereinafter set out in the aggregate amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars, which said bonds shall be designated Road Bonds of 1921, and shall be Two Hundred Fifty (250) in number, numbered from One (1) to Two Hundred Fifty (250) both inclusive, of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, and shall be dated September 15th, 1921, and shall become due and payable \$10,000.00 on september 15th, of each of the years 1922 to 1946 inclusive, and bear interest from their date until paid at the rate of six per cen (6%) per annum payable semi-annually on the fifteenth day of March and September of each year, which installments of interest to date of maturity of principal shall be evidenced by appropriate coupons attached to each of said bonds, both principal and interest shall be payable in lawful money of the United State of America at the fiscal agency of the State of Oklahoma, in the City of New York, State of New York, or in the event of the discontinuance of said fiscal agency, then at the Mechanics and Metals National bank in said City and State of New York,

Section two: That each of the said bonds, the coupons thereto attached, and the endorsement and certificates thereon shall be in the following form:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Dawson Township, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, hereby acknowledges itself indebted to and for value received, promises to pay the bearer the sum of One Thousand Dollars on the 15th day of September, 19____, together with interest thereon, from the date hereof until paid at the rate of six per centum (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the 15th days of March and September, of each year, said interest evidenced by and to be paid upon the surrender of the coupon hereto attached, as the severally become due, both principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United State of America at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oklahoma, in the City of New York, State of New York, or in the event of the discontinuance of said agency then at the Mechanics and Metals National Bank of said City in the State of New York.

This bond is one of a series numbered from One to Two Hundred and Fifty (1 to 250) both inclusive of like date and tenor except as to maturity, aggregating a principal sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) dollars, and is issued for the purpose of improving roads in aid township by draining, grading, gravelling and macadamizing same.

Under Section 26, Article 10 of the constitution of the State of Oklahoma, and Article One, Chapter 73, of the Revised Laws of Oklahoma, 1910, as amended by Chapter 235 session laws of the State of Oklahoma, 1917, ~~and~~ and other statutes of the state supplementary and ammendatory thereto.

The full face, credit, and resources of said township are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of this bond.
