A resolution was passed by the Board of County Commissioners that they appropriate \$2,000.00 to be used in enlarging the Detention Home, which is now the property of Tulsa County.

Hardesty, (as petitioners), filed a petition to open a road between sections 25 and 36, township 22, range 12-E. 80 rods East of section line, and running thence open road East along said section line for 80 rods to the North and South section line along sec. 25-36 the East side of said section. along Sec.
6-19-10.

It is ordered by the County Commissioners to open up a public highway along the section line on the North side of section 6-19-10 in Tulsa County, Oklahoma. Beginning at a point where East and West section line extends across the line of right-of-way of the A. V. & W. Railway Company, running thence East to the Northeast Corner of said section 6, more particularly described as lots 1-2 and 3, in section 6, township 19, range 10-E.
